Other Digital Collections

- Electronic Exhibits such as "Into the Western Country"
- Mormons and Their Neighbors (100,000 sketches appearing in 236 published volumes)
- Mountain West Digital Library – aggregation of digital collections from hosting institutions such as universities, colleges, public libraries, museums, and historical societies in Utah, Nevada, and Idaho.
- Relief Society Magazine Index 1914-1970. The magazine is not in digital form.

Utah Local History Bibliography

- Approximately 8,000 printed and published local history titles which includes newspapers, oral histories, diaries, autobiographies, family histories, government publications, environmental studies, sociological studies.
- Seven libraries involved: BYU, FHL, SUU, UU, Utah State Historical Society, Utah State University, Weber State University, Dixie College, selected public libraries.

- Items in the boxed collections are inventoried; but most items do not appear in the BYU online catalog.
- The microfilm collection is a rich source of Mormon material which includes such things as: diaries, Mormon historical literature, anti-Mormon literature, biographies, histories of branches, districts, missions and wards.
- Estimated 30,000 items.
- Inventory is in progress and a partial list will be available in the BYU Special Collections Library this summer (2009).
